

## Summer Camp Information 2010

We will meet at the North Entrance at 9:30am, Monday July 26th. We will load the bus and leave at 10:00am. We should arrive back by 1:30pm Friday, July 30th.

### What do I pack?

\*Comfortable clothes and tennis shoes. Sleeveless shirts must have straps that are no less than an inch wide and midriffs must be covered. Shorts should not be shorter than the tips of the camper's fingers with their arms extended toward their knees.

\*Bring a jacket just in case!

\*Swim suit- One-piece swim suits only. No bikinis or tankinis. (not even with a t-shirt over it)

\*Shower shoes

\*Linens- include twin size sheets, and/or sleeping bag and pillow

\*Towels, toiletries, personal items

\*Bible and pen/pencil

\*Umbrella, flashlight, sunscreen, bug spray

\***Please have your child wear a watch.** (Cheap digital ones are best.)

\*DO NOT pack shaving cream, silly string, or any "pranking" items

\*The camp DOES NOT allow video games, CD players, iPods, MP3 players, etc.\*\*If you would like these items for the bus ride, please note that they will be taken up by our leaders and stored until the bus ride home. **YOU MUST BE AWARE THAT THERE IS NO PLACE FOR US TO LOCK UP THESE ITEMS.** You will be sending them at your own risk.

### LABLE ALL ITEMS, CLOTHES, ETC.

Medicines: Please place them in a ziplock bag, clearly labeled, with child's name and specific dosage instructions. DO NOT pack this in their bag, but give to Traci before we load the bus.

### How about money?

\*Please send your child's money in 3 separate envelopes:

1) Snack Shack Money 2) Lunch Money, July 26th 3) Book Store

1) Snack Shack- If a camper wants to buy any items from the Snack Shack, he/she must purchase a SNACK SHACK CARD. **CASH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR PURCHASES AT THE SNACK SHACK.** Snack Shack Cards may be purchased for \$5 each. Any unused amounts on SNACK SHACK CARDS may be redeemed on

Friday before leaving camp. (APPROXIMATE PRICES: popcorn- \$.50, candy- \$.75, sno-cones- \$.75, drinks- \$1.50, ice cream- \$1.25, hot dogs- \$1.50, nachos- \$1.50)

- 2) July 27th we will stop to eat lunch in Clarksville. Send enough for a fast food meal. **DO NOT PACK THIS IN THEIR SUITCASE. THEY NEED IT ON THE BUS RIDE.**
- 3) Book Store- Camp souvenirs, T-shirts, toiletries, gifts, etc. are available for purchase. T-shirt costs range from \$8.00 to \$20.00.

## **How about food?**

Breakfast: A hot breakfast is served each morning and changes daily. A cold breakfast (cereal, fruit, pastry) is offered every day.

Lunch and Dinner: A hot meal is served each day and changes daily. A hot dog and/or hamburger is offered every meal, as well as a salad bar offering.

Bread and peanut butter are available at all meals.

## **What about communication?**

Campers can receive mail from family and friends. It usually takes 2-3 days for mail to reach the Arkansas Baptist Assembly, so send mail early!
